Did you know that Vicki Wickliffe has been caring for the City of Lake Mills Flower Beds that are scattered throughout Lake Mills for over 20 years? Vicki stated that she would walk by City Flower Beds and would find herself picking weeds as she wandered by. While visiting Montello, WI, she noticed City Flower Beds were taken care of by community groups and volunteers. Vicki brought this idea to the Parks Board, and took on the management of the Flower Bed Volunteers.


